BLANCHE L. KING SCHOLARSHIP

The BLK Scholarship program is funded by the Women's Ministries of the International Pentecostal Holiness Church to assist children of IPHC missionaries in furthering their education at one of the denominational colleges. The scholarship is named in honor of the third General Woman's Auxiliary (now Women's Ministries) president and the wife of Bishop J.H. King. Mrs. King had the distinction of being the first teacher hired for Franklin Springs Institute (now Emmanuel College) in 1919 and gave the baccalaureate address for the 50th anniversary of the college in 1969. She had a love for missionaries and a concern for the education of children of missionaries.

Women of the IPHC raise awareness of this opportunity to assist children of missionaries with offerings being received annually on or near Mrs. King's birthday (July 4th). These offerings are sent to General Women's Ministries for distribution.

Guidelines

1. Scholarships are restricted to children of missionaries of the IPHC who are currently on assignment or are on furlough for the purpose of itinerating.
2. Students who have been formally accepted for full-time enrollment at an IPHC college are eligible for the scholarship.
3. Applications must be made annually and will be used for the academic year for which they are granted.
4. Applicants must meet moral standards set by the college and maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.0 to qualify for the BLK Scholarship.
5. Applications are made for each school term and should be in the General WM Office by:
 - a. July 1st for Fall Semester (if entering at beginning of academic year)
 - b. December 1st for Winter Semester (if entering college mid-term)
6. Funds are disbursed on a semester basis from the IPHC RDC and revert to the BLK Scholarship Fund if the student withdraws from college.
7. Fund availability determines the amount of the annual scholarship.
